Traditionally, Guideboat ribs were cut from spruce stumps. Our approach is to steam, bend and then laminate straight spruce stock. Note the pressure cooker with hoses below the steam box. On top of the box is our jig with clamps for pulling the steamed spruce layers into conformance with our mold. The ribs will sit in the jig until they are dry ...

Building Adirondack Guide-Boats . . . Beginning in the later part of the 1800s the guide-boat had reached a level of sophistication that has come to define the boat. Typically, guide-boats are in the range of 15 to 17 feet, with a beam of 36 to 39 inches, and a weight of 65 to 75 pounds.

Of these builders, the best known were Theodore Hamner and his son Willard, of Saranac Lake. Willard operated his shop until his death in 1962. Carl Hathaway bought the shop in 1963 and operated it through 1990. He and Ralph Morrow were the last two builders of the time until NCCC hired them to teach a boat building course in 1980.
