Tetanus-containing vaccine is recommended in a 5-dose schedule at 2, 4, 6 and 18 months, and 4 years of age. Infants and children receive tetanus toxoid in combination with diphtheria toxoid and acellular pertussis, as DTPa (diphtheria-tetanus-acellular pertussis)-containing vaccines.. Infants can have their 1st dose of tetanus-containing vaccine as early as 6 weeks of age.
